The liner Orduna (15,507 tons gross), after she arrives at Liverpool tomorrow with troops and families from Singapore, will be towed to Newport for breaking up. Built in 1914 by Harland & Wolff, Ltd., Belfast, for the Pacific Steam Navigation Company, she will follow to the breakers' yard the Orbita, which was sold for scrap last September.
