S The Committee have had before them a report of survey carried out by the Society's Surveyors at Liverpool last month, from which it is noted the vessel has been seen in drydock, and an examination made of the port and centre screwshafts.

The port screwshaft has been renewed, but it is recommended that the liner of the centre screwshaft should be renewed before the end of August 1951.

The Committee have confirmed this recommendation, and have continued the vessel's class subject to this renewal being effected by the date stated above, it being concluded that you will make arrangements accordingly.

I have pleasure in informing you that records of docking survey and port screwshaft renewal with date of 8,50 have been assigned at this time.
