I have to acquaint you that in June last the Owners of this vessel were advised that the Committee had agreed the completion of the Special Survey being postponed until her return to this country within about three months, subject to a satisfactory report being received on her condition when the requisite survey for extension of the Dead Weight Certificate, which expired on the 31st July last, took place. It was understood the inspection in question would be held at Buenos Aires in July.

It is noted from your Return of Vessels under Survey dated the 30th July last that the vessel came under your inspection for damage, and I shall accordingly be glad if you will advise me of the present circumstances of this case.

You will note that the Donkey Boiler Survey became due at the end of July last.
