I duly received your letter of the 22nd instant the contents of which are noted, and I may say that an airletter has been sent to the Society's Surveyors at Buenos Aires, requesting them to extend this vessel's Load Line Certificate until the 30th September next after satisfactory inspection.

As regards the outstanding items of Special Survey I beg to point out that as stated in my letter of the 18th instant the fore peak spaces (not the fore peak tank) require to be examined. The other items mentioned by you were examined only as for General Examination at Liverpool, but not as for Special Survey. Accordingly these parts will require to be examined on the occasion of the completion of the Special Survey.
