

S.S. "BOSTONIAN".

This vessel was built by Messrs. Harland & Wolff at Glasgow and launched on the 19th January 1915, the last date of survey being the 6th December, 1915. By the Rules the date of build should be entered as July 1915. In view of the delay in the completion of the vessel caused primarily by the War, and as the vessel was examined in Dry Dock on the 11th November and found in good condition, the Surveyor recommends that the date of build should be entered as December 1915, as was done in the case of the same Builders' vessels "FALSTRIA" and "KANGAROO".

This case was considered by the Glasgow Committee on the 14th December, when they decided to refer the question of the date of build to the General Committee.

It is submitted that in the circumstances the date of build may be entered as December 1915.
