I am in receipt of Montreal Report No.8358 together with your later letter of the 16th instant regarding this case and note the position.

The reports have been submitted to the Committee who have deferred the question of assignment of a casualty notation until early next month by which time they hope a reply will have been received to a letter addressed to the Owners on the 31st ultimo, a copy of which is enclosed.

It is observed from the Shipping Press that the steamer had a heavy list when she left Philadelphia on the 15th October with a cargo of 800 tons of anthracite and that this ultimately led to her abandonment and loss.

It is concluded you have no special remarks to make regarding the survey held at Montreal, but should you have any comments to offer it will be appreciated if you will kindly forward them to me at an early date.
