

Your letter of the 31st ult. addressed to Compania de Navegacion Mundial Soc. Anon., has been opened by me, as I am handling the correspondence for this Corporation pending legal arrangements by the heirs, as both owners; i.e. the Captain and the Chief Engineer, were lost with the ship.

According to the information I have from the United States Coast Guard, the vessel is a total loss, having sunk off the coast of Newfoundland on October 22nd, with twelve officers and crew.

There were eight survivors picked up in a life-boat by the United States Coast Guard.
