With reference to your First Entry Report No. 8327 on the S.S. "ABRUCATE", I shall be glad if you will be good enough to forward the originally approved plans of this vessel, as the plans forwarded only appear to be copies.

You should also indicate the sizes and positions of the pillars in the bridge and poop 'tween decks, in order that it may be seen if any additional pillaring is necessary, and state whether the scantlings and arrangements where not indicated on the plans (including the panting arrangements and strengthening of bottom forward) are to your satisfaction.

Your First Entry report is returned herewith for completion and signature, and I shall be glad if you will forward on Report Form No. 8 a report of the survey held, and state whether the requirements of Section 48 of the Rules have been complied with, and whether a Special Survey No. 3 has been carried out.
