I duly received Mr. Mackirdy's letter of the 1st instant forwarding for the consideration of the Committee a provisional report giving particulars of shafting and pumping arrangements of the S.S. "ARBROATH", together with a plan of the pumping arrangements, and with regard thereto I am directed to inform you that provided the modifications to the pumping arrangements set forth in Mr. Mackirdy's letter mentioned above be satisfactorily carried out and the machinery of this vessel be found satisfactory when tested under full working conditions, the same will be accepted for a working pressure of 200 lbs. per sq. in., and the record of LMC (with date) without the distinguishing mark * be assigned on receipt of a satisfactory report.

It is noted that an amended pumping plan will be forwarded in due course.
