Dear Sirs,

With reference to Mr. Mackirdy's letter of the 8th instant submitting for the consideration of the Committee a plan of the main boilers of the S.S. "ALEXANDRA" built in 1909 under the supervision of the Surveyors to the Germanischer Lloyd, I have to acquaint you that provided the boilers be examined throughout; the furnaces be found to shew no sign of strain; the scantlings be in accordance with the plan, and the boilers be found in good order and safe working condition, they will be accepted, in this instance, for the original working pressure of 14 kilogrammes per square centimetre, say 200 lbs per square inch.

I have to add that in the event of the Owners deciding to submit the vessel to survey with a view to classification in this Society's Register Book, particulars of the cylinders, shafting, diameter of propeller, and whether the screw shaft is fitted with a continuous liner or otherwise, should be forwarded.

A plan of the pumping arrangements should also be

The plan referred to is being returned to your address to-day under separate cover.

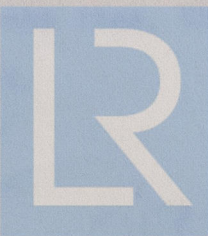
