Dear Mr. Weber,

We have information in this Office to the effect that the Finnish steamer "EDNA" of 829 tons, built in 1905 and classed with this Society disappeared without trace off the Norwegian coast on the 7th instant whilst on a voyage from Thamshavn to a U.K. port with a cargo of wood pulp.

It is of course the duty of the Committee to record 'Casualty' in the Register Book once the loss has been established, and I shall be glad to have any comments you may have to make which might throw some light upon her disappearance.

Perhaps the Finnish Government are making an Inquiry, and if so we shall be pleased to learn what happened and whether there are any reasons yet established for her loss.
