Dear Sirs,

I duly received your memorandum of the 28th November last intimating that the steamer "NAIRANA" is still laid up under offer for sale.

A record of "Laid up pending survey" was assigned in this case in May 1948, and the Committee cannot agree to her class particulars remaining in the Register Book unless they receive an assurance from the Society's Surveyors that the vessel has been satisfactorily maintained during this long lay-up period of nearly three years.

I shall therefore be glad if you will inform the present Owners that unless they are prepared to offer facilities for you to undertake a general examination to satisfy themselves on this point, her class particulars will be omitted from the reprint of the Register Book. *Committee*

Please let me know as soon as possible what they propose doing in the matter.
