In accordance with the arrangements made by wire yesterday. I proceeded to Peterhead by the first train this morning, and visited the two steam drifters. "City of London" & "City of Edinburgh". I found that the customary casing gear, has not been fitted to the boiler safety valves, and until this is done, I am unable to recommend the machinery of these vessels, for classification in the Society's Register Book.

In view of the urgency of the matter, I should be glad to leave from you, when the work has been completed, in order that I may come and inspect the gear, and furnish a report for the information of the Committee.
