

Kinugasa Maru Sinks In N. Pacific

YOKOHAMA, Nov. 19.—The Kinugasa Maru of the Hashimoto Steamship Co. sank today at 1.58 p.m. at 32.09 degrees north latitude and 168.35 degrees east longitude (1,400 miles from Choshi, Chiba Prefecture), according to a report received by the third district headquarters of the Maritime Safety Board from the patrol ship Daio at 3.30 p.m.

The 42 members of the Kinugasa Maru's crew who had been transferred to the rescue ship Kamikawa Maru of the Kawasaki Steamship Co. were re-transferred this morning at 8.50 to the Daio, from which they will again be transferred to the patrol boat Muroto which is scheduled to arrive at the scene November 21 in order to carry them to Japan.
