This vessel was built in 1914 and classed with Germanischer Lloyd. Plans were examined and the vessel approved for the class 100 A1 with freeboard, provided the equipment be found to be in accordance with the Rules.

Reports have now been received from the Hamburg Surveyors giving particulars of scantlings, etc., which are generally in accordance with those approved.

The vessel has been examined in dry-dock, bottom cleaned and coated, the requirements of Sec. 48 of the Rules complied with, S.S. No. 2 carried out and minor repairs effected.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to be
classed:-
