

Ex-German Steamer "TIRPITZ".

I discussed the case of this vessel also with Mr. Martin at our interview to-day.

Mr. Martin states that this vessel is proceeding to the "Vulcan" Works and is also to be fitted for burning oil fuel, the arrangements being in the hands of Messrs. Biles, who are acting as the Consulting Engineers of the Canadian Pacific Ocean Services. As this is a new vessel Mr. Martin concludes that no drilling of the plating will be necessary and no serious amount of opening up will be requisite or structural alterations required, and provided that this is the case they are quite willing to submit the vessel for classification. They desire, however, to have a letter from us tomorrow (18th instant) stating what are the Society's minimum requirements in order that this may be at once passed on to Messrs. Biles and that there may be no misunderstanding in the matter.

This vessel will be leaving Immingham on Saturday for the "Vulcan" Works.
