

Steel S.S. "CRACOVIA".

This vessel was built at Trieste by the Cantiere San Rocco, for local Owners.

She was commenced in March 1913, was launched on the 5th February 1916, and has recently been completed (last date of survey 20th November 1920).

The Surveyor states that the vessel was moored partly at the Builders' Yard and partly at the Arsenal of the Lloyd Triestino, the Owners of the ship, from the day she was launched until the trials were run. All the tanks were examined internally in August 1920, and the holds, 'tweendecks, peaks, decks, bottom, rudder &c. were examined during the months of September, October and November last and found in very good condition.

In the circumstances, as the vessel appears to have been carefully attended to during the War, and has throughout been under the supervision of the Society's Surveyors, who have recently examined her, as mentioned above, it is submitted that the Date of Build in this case might be recorded as November 1920, as approved by the General Committee in previous similar cases.
