

Nature of Survey _____

It is submitted the Hull Surveyor be requested to state whether the sheenstroke has been doubled at the break of the quarter deck & also to forward the sketch of bulkheads which it is stated on profile would be submitted.

They should also furnish particulars of the test & weights of stocks of the sheen & keel anchor, if these have been supplied of the weights stated instead of as required.

The midship section should be returned & the Surveyor requested to amend same to agree with the report & vessel as built as regards the thickness of the shell plating.
