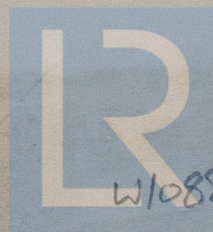
On the 26th of April 1947, one of the Societies' Surveyors in Sweden, Mr. P. O. Sjøgren, surveyed part of the Machinery of this vessel, and recommended that a new condenser shell should be fitted. This recommendation was attended to during the vessels stay at Oslo the following month.

In connection with settlement re this condenser damage, we are searching for the possible cause why the shell fractured, and we should appreciate very much receiving copy of Mr. Sjøgrens Report regarding this particular damage.
