With reference to the case of your motor tanker "JANKO" which broke in two in the Bay of Biscay in January last, I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee of this Society feel that although the after portion arrived safely in port at Falmouth in March, they cannot regard her as a classed ship until such time as repairs and renewals have been effected; and in order to make this clear in the Society's Register Book they have given instructions for a casualty notation of "Broken in two - after portion now in port" to be recorded.
