A letter has been received from Messrs. N.V. Ned. Dok My of this Port intimating that they have secured the order to rebuild the lost foreship of the m.v. "JAGUAR", no. 88658 in the R.B., and to bring the vessel in a similar condition as she was in before.

In connection therewith we shall be glad to receive the approved plans of this vessel for our guidance.

Further, we beg to forward to your address under separate cover for your approval two plans, in quadruplicate, showing the proposed amended arrangements of the carrying through of the continuous centre keelson through the oiltight transverse bulkheads and the connecting of the thwartship brackets to the longitudinal bulkheads.

We beg to draw your attention to the proposed closing weld given on drawing no. 83001 and the welding of the straps to the longitudinal bulkheads shown on drawing no. 83002 at top for connecting the beam brackets which are only 4 mm.

Will you be so kind as to return three copies of each of the plans to this office at your earliest convenience.
