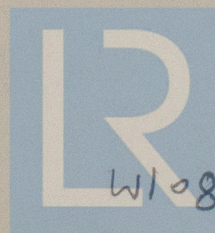
Vessel's Name: s.s. "CLAN MACNAIR".

We have to thank you for your letter dated 11th instant from which we note that Special Survey becomes due on the above vessel at the end of next month.

We regret that at the present time owing to the delay which we are experiencing in the delivery of new vessels, together with out present cargo commitments it would not be convenient to r arrange to put this vessel out of service at the end of next month for the purpose of carrying out the Special Survey. We shall, therefore, be glad if in view of these circumstances, you would consider postponement of the Special Survey until August 1953.

The vessel is expected to arrive on the home coast on the 22nd August and after going to various coastal ports is due to arrive at Glasgow about the 12th September. We would, therefore, propose to dry dock the vessel at that port and carry out the general examination if this is agreeable to your Committee.

We, therefore, look forward to hearing from you in due course.
