Dear Mr. Warlow,

With reference to your telegram of yesterday's date respecting the case of the steamer "CLAN MACNAIR", it is noted that the work required to the escape holes in the tween decks will receive attention on the vessel's return.

As, however, your Committee have assigned a clean record of survey in this case, not having the facts regarding the escape holes before them at the time, I conclude that it would not be in order for the certificate to be issued without a condition being added.

In the circumstances I return the first entry report and also enclose the first entry certificates with the condition attached, and if the Committee are agreeable, you might add the word "subject" to the minute and get it initialled by Mr. Scott Brown.

Will you be so kind as to let me have the report back in due course?
