

These vessels have recently been completed on the Clyde,
and First Entry Reports have been forwarded from Glasgow.

The "CLAN MACNAIR" was launched in March 1921 and the
"LEIGHTON" in January 1921, and in accordance with Paragraph 7,
Page 10 of the General Regulations the Date of Build for ships
not exceeding 10,000 tons gross should be not later than six
months after the date of launching.

The last date of the survey in the case of each of the above
vessels was October 1921, and the Glasgow Committee recommend
for the consideration of the General Committee that the Date of
Build should be recorded in the Register Book as October 1921,
the completion of the vessel in each case having been delayed
owing to the Joiners' Strike and the Coal Strike.

It is submitted that the recommendation of the
Glasgow Committee might, in the circumstances, be concurred in.
