The screwshaft survey became due on this vessel in November and the Boiler Survey in February last.

At the end of last year the vessel was reported to have sustained extensive damage during a cyclone and to be laid up at Havana.

In the circumstances, the usual undertaking was obtained from the Owners, but from a letter now received from the Society's Surveyor at Havana, it would appear that the steamer has been sold to the Boston Iron and Metal Company, of Baltimore, and she is to be towed to that port to be broken up.

In the circumstances, the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Tuesday, the 26th ultimo, decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (8.27), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Owners have been informed accordingly.
