

H. Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "BARCELONA", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Havana in which he states he has been informed by your Representative at that port that this vessel is laid up there in a damaged condition, and is for sale. In the circumstances the Committee will be agreeable to the screwshaft and boiler surveys, which became due in November, 1926 and February last respectively, and the carrying out of the requisite damage repairs being postponed for the present in the event of it not being convenient to you to complete the same at an early date on the conditions they usually require in the cases of vessels which are overdue for survey and are lying up indefinitely, viz:- that the surveys and repairs be carried out before the vessel is again sent to sea, and that you undertake to have this done if she remain your property, and, should she be offered for sale, to inform intending purchasers that the class is allowed to remain subject to this being done.
