In December last the Barcelona Surveyor stated the vessel was lying in a damaged condition at Havana and would require to be drydocked and have the screwshaft examined.

The Barcelona Surveyor wrote on the 21st March last that the vessel was extensively damaged in a cyclone about six months previously and was still laid up at Havana, and that the Owners could make no definite arrangements in regard to the Boiler Survey, and in the circumstances the Committee deferred the consideration of the case for a time.

In reply to inquiry the Havana Surveyor now states the vessel is laid up <sup>in the "Graveyard"</sup> with a watchman on board and
