With a view to classification with the Society, the Society the vessel was recently examined by the Newcastle Surveyors and some additional strengthening fitted and on the 13th inst. the class 100 A1 "Shelter Dk. with freeboard" was assigned & notation of S.S.No.3.

Twenty visits were paid by the Surveyors in connection with the survey of the hull and 15 machinery.

Had the vessel been built under survey the fees would have been approximately as follows:-
