No plans or B.C. Reports have been submitted for our examination

I beg to acquaint you that the Society's Surveyors at Kobe have forwarded to this Office a translation of your letter, dated 16th September, addressed to them, from which it is noted that it is not your intention to continue the classification of your steamer "SUKI MARU" with this Society.

With regard thereto, I have to state that the Committee have had this case under consideration at their meeting today and, in view of your intimation and of the fact that the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Second Special Survey No.1 of this vessel expired at the end of August last, they regret they have had no alternative but to give instructions for the vessel's character to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line, indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
