
The Second Special Survey No.1, due 8,29, was partly held at Kobe in July, 1929, by the internal examination of the double bottom tanks and fore and after peak tanks.

On the 26th November the Classing Committee approved a proposal of the Owners to complete the Special Survey at the next Annual Survey of the vessel, to be held in August, 1930.

Enquiry was made of the Kobe Surveyors on the 3rd ultimo regarding the completion of the Special Survey, and in reply they now forward a translation of a letter from the Owners intimating that as the vessel has now been classed with the British Corporation they regret they have decided to withdraw the classification of this Society.

The year of grace expired 8,30.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, 17th instant, and in the circumstances decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a Red Line (———), indicating non-compliance with the Rules. 10,30
