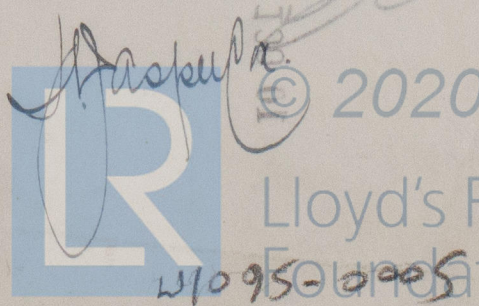
Dear Sir,

Reverting to your letter of the 26th. November 1929 in which you stated that the Committee had agreed to the Owners' proposal to postpone the completion of the 2nd.
