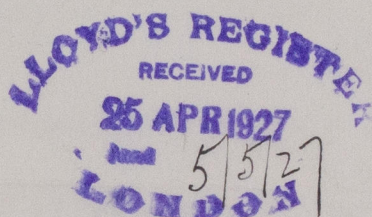

With reference to the case of the Trawler "Fernando" we beg to inform you that this vessel arrived at this port on the 17th, inst, and was visited on that date by a surveyor to this Society, who explained the requirements of the Committee in detail.

It was arranged that the owners representative would advise us as soon as the vessel was ready, but on visiting the ship this morning the 19th, inst, it was found that no preparations had been made and that the vessel was proposing to sail again this evening.

In the circumstances nothing was done at this time towards carrying out the S.S. No2 so long overdue.
