Dear Sirs,

H. With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of the steam trawler "FERNANDO", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had under their consideration a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Cadiz in which they state they have been informed that it is your intention to submit the boiler, part of the engine and the hull internally for examination, as part of the 2nd Special Survey No.2, on the vessel's arrival at Cadiz about the present time. In the circumstances the Committee desire me to point out that the 2nd Special Survey No.2 became due so long ago as October, 1925, and that the year of grace allowed by the Society's Rules expired at the end of October last and to say that arrangements must be made for the survey to be completed at the present time if the vessel is to retain her class. I shall therefore be glad to learn, for the Committee's information, that you have given instructions accordingly.
