

TRANSLATION.

RODRIGUEZ RINCON HERMANOS.

Dear Sir,

We are in receipt of your letter of the 7th instant respecting the classification and the Special Survey No.2 of the fishing steamer "FERNANDO".

It is our intention to retain the classification of the vessel, and we have, therefore, asked your Agent at Cadiz to carry out the Survey as stated by you, i.e. the Boiler, the Machinery and the inside of the hull, leaving the vessel until the first opportunity that the vessel has to be put on the slipway, as to do so now would cause us serious loss.

We, therefore, ask you to be good enough to give instructions to the Cadiz Office to carry out that part of the survey at the first arrival of the vessel in port, allowing a short delay for the rest until the vessel is put on the slipway.

To delay the vessel for the whole survey now, would cause us very serious loss as fishing has been bad so far, and is beginning to give results now.

We should feel grateful if you accept our request, and for the future we will see that the surveys are carried out at the right time.
