Dear Sirs,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your steamer "TOYO MARU No.2", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them to-day a communication received from the Society's Surveyors at Nagasaki, from which it appears you have informed them that it is not your desire to maintain the vessel's class with the Society, and I am directed to say that in the circumstances instructions have been given for the steamer's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.


I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate, which has been returned to this Office by the Nagasaki Surveyors, has accordingly been cancelled.
