The First Special Survey No. 2 of this vessel became due in August last year, and was carried out at that time at Kobe, with the exception of the testing of all double bottom and peak tanks, the lifting of the ceiling, the re-examination of No. 3 double bottom tank internally, and the scaling and coating of all holds and bunkers.

The Owners have now informed the Society's Surveyors at Kobe that it is not desired to maintain the classification of the steamer in the Society's Register Book, and in the circumstances the Classing Committee, who had the case before them on Tuesday, 25th instant, decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
