This vessel became due in June last for Modified Survey of the Oil Engines and for Screw Shaft Survey.

The Consulting Engineer for the Owners now states that the vessel is to be laid up as a store ship and will not again be placed in commission, and in the circumstances the Owners do not desire the class to be retained.

The Classing Committee had the case before them on Friday, 4th instant, and decided to give instructions for the vessel's character to be withdrawn from the Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.
