Messrs. The Hudson's Bay Co., Ltd., Vancouver, B.C., survey the Wood Auxiliary Schooner "BAYMAUD", 385 tons gross register, of London, Official Number 148758, in dry dock and afloat and during alterations and repairs, for the purpose of Classification in Lloyd's Register of Shipping.

I have transmitted a Report to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, stating that the Hull and Rudder, Mast, Spars, etc., are in satisfactory condition, and recommending that the vessel be granted Class 9.A.6.26, being fit to carry dry and perishable cargoes.

The Main Motor and Auxiliary Engines have been surveyed throughout; a new Tube Shaft fitted, and the Sea Connections, Stern Bush and fastenings of Propeller examined.

I have recommended to the Committee of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, London, that the vessel's Machinery be classed with Notation L.M.C. 6.26.
