Referring to my letter of the 2nd October last, and to previous correspondence, respecting your auxiliary sailing ship "CAP NORD", I have to inform you that the Committee have again had this case before them to-day in connexion with a letter which has been received from the Society's Surveyors Copenhagen, from which it appears that you have advised them that you desire a further postponement of three weeks in respect of this vessel's classification, as you are in negotiation with prospective buyers from Sweden.

The Committee, in all the circumstances, have agreed to defer action for the three weeks desired, but I am directed to say that unless by that time, if the vessel is still held up, the general examination referred to in my letter of the 6th September last is held, or in the event of a sale the overdue Special Survey is carried out, the vessel's name will be expunged from the Register Book.

I take this opportunity to remind you that I do not appear to have received any acknowledgment of my letters to you of the 6th September and 2nd October last respecting this case.
