Dear Sir,

With reference to my letter of the 6th ultimo, to which I do not appear to have been favoured with a reply, respecting your auxiliary sailing ship "CAP NORD", I beg to acquaint you that the Committee have now had the case before them, together with a letter received from the Society's Surveyors at Copenhagen, in which it is stated that you have informed them that you are at present negotiating with German buyers, and that you ask that the vessel's class may remain undisturbed for a month; also that in the event of the vessel being sold, you will immediately inform this Office of the name and address of the buyers.

In the circumstances the Committee have decided to defer action in the matter for a month, as you desire, subject to the conditions laid down in my letter of the 6th ultimo, and it is to be understood that you will inform intending purchasers of the conditions under which the vessel retains her class.
