
Indented shell plating etc. in way of Nos. 1 and 2 tanks (s.s) and in way of Nos. 2 and 3 summer tanks (p.s) requires to be dealt with at Owners' convenience.

The 1st S.S. No. 2 was commenced at Birkenhead in 10.39 and advanced at Falmouth in the following April, but the greater part of the Survey still remains to be dealt with.

A General Examination was made in October last and a notation of 'Examined 10.40', valid for 6 months, assigned. A further General Examination consequently becomes due at the end of the present month.

In reply to enquiry the Owners write the ship is abroad and her future movements uncertain. They will, however, see that the necessary examinations are held at the first possible opportunity.

It is submitted action be deferred.
