Reports have come to hand from the Newcastle Surveyors from which it appears that these engines have been fitted on board the Motorship "BRITISH SCIENCE", which vessel has today been classed 100A1, Carrying Petroleum in Bulk, with notations of Lloyd's A & C P, LMC 1,31, C.L., Oil Eng., etc.
