We beg to confirm the information which has been passed between us to-day as follows:-  
86769 "BRITISH SCIENCE". Classed #100A1, Carrying Petroleum in Bulk, with notations of Lloyd's A & C P, #LMC 1,31, C.L., Registered. "BRITISH SCIENCE" SUPPLYING PORT OWNERS SHIPBOARD MACHINERY Oil Eng., etc.

It is concluded that the Rule length of the vessel is 440 feet not 460 feet as reported, and that the number for the scantlings of the rudder is as approved, but I shall be glad if you will confirm these points.

I have also to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 9th instant confirming the telegrams which passed in regard thereto between us yesterday regarding the certificates, and have to say that in the circumstances these have been handed over to the Owners.

Your remarks in regard to the payment of the fees are duly noted.
