I return herewith one copy of the plan, forwarded with your letter of the 20th instant, of cylindrical boiler proposed for the above contract, and in confirmation of my telegram to you to-day, as below, have to inform you that this amended plan will be approved for a working pressure of 220 lb. per sq. inch, provided the boiler be constructed under the usual conditions of survey and testing.

The Steel Testing Surveyors should be advised regarding the tensile strength of the shell plates, butt straps and girders, viz:- 29-33 tons per sq. inch.

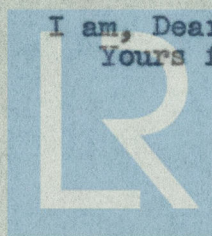
