S. With reference to the classification in the Register Book of the Steamer "MELUSIA", No. 29014, I have to acquaint you that it would appear from a cablegram received from the Society's Surveyor at Singapore that this vessel has left that port without completing the Second Special Survey No. 3 as required by the Committee, and as the new Owners, The China Pacific Steam Navigation Co. Ltd., are resident at Shanghai, I enclose herewith a letter which has to-day been addressed to them, intimating that the vessel's class has been expunged from the Register Book with a red line, on account of non-compliance with the Rules.
