The Second Special Survey No. 3, which became due on this vessel in August 1926, has been partly held, and on the 13th September last the late Owners were asked to furnish the usual undertaking, in view of the fact that the vessel was reported to be laid up at Singapore.

It is now stated that the Steamer has been sold to The China Pacific Steam Navigation Co. Ltd of Shanghai, and in reply to inquiry the Singapore Surveyor cables that nothing has been done towards the completion of the Special Survey at his port and that she is now at Shanghai.

The case received the consideration of the Classing Committee on Friday, the 4th instant, when it was decided to give instructions for the vessel's class to be expunged from the Register Book with a red line (11.27), indicating non-compliance with the Society's Rules, and the Shanghai Surveyor has been requested by cable to inform the new Owners accordingly.
