Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to the classification in this Society's Register Book of your steamer "MELUSIA", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a communication received from the Society's Surveyors at Sydney, from which it appears that the vessel is laid up at Singapore pending sale.

In the circumstances, I have to state that as the year of grace allowed for the completion of the Second Special Survey No.3, which became due in August 1926, has now expired, the Committee can agree to the vessel's class in the Society's Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present only subject to the conditions usually required by them in similar cases, viz.:— that the overdue survey and all necessary repairs be completed before the vessel again proceeds to sea, and that you undertake to have this done if she remain your property, and should she be offered for sale to inform intending purchasers that the class is allowed to remain subject to this being done.

I shall therefore be glad to learn that you are willing to agree to these conditions, and that you will immediately advise this Office of the name and address of
