Dear Sirs,

S. With reference to your letter of the 29th ultimo, addressed to the Society's Surveyors at Marseilles, respecting your steamer "MADO", I beg to acquaint you that in view of your intimation, the Committee, who have had the case of this vessel before them to-day, have given instructions for the steamer's character to be withdrawn from the Society's Register Book and three dots (...) inserted in lieu thereof, indicating withdrawal of class at Owners' request.

I have to add that in view of the withdrawal of this vessel's class the record of the freeboard assigned by the Committee, together with the corresponding draught, will also be withdrawn, and the freeboard certificate is thereby cancelled and should be returned to this Office.
