- TWO - Gunmetal Stern Tubes, fitted with white metal after bush, and gunmetal neck rings and gland.
- TWO - Gunmetal Propellers, bored and keyway cut, (Propellers fitted to shafts), also coned caps for propeller nuts.
- TWO - Gunmetal "A" Bracket Bushes, lined with lignum vitae.
- TWO - Intermediate Shafts with forged Flanges, together with 36 coupling bolts.
- TWO - Tunnel Bearings for Intermediate Shaft.
- TWO - Gunmetal Sleeve Pieces for carrying Stern Tubes.

Built to the order of Messrs. Vickers-Petters Ltd, Ipswich and intended for the Motor Yacht " FLYING CLOUD ".

The Several parts have been examined for workmanship and found satisfactory.
