I enclose a letter, dated 17th instant, received from the Society's Surveyors at Southampton, regarding the case of the auxiliary yacht "FLYING CLOUD" ex "ELIZABETH RUTH". This vessel, as you will see from the reports, was built in June 1918, at Biloxi, Miss. and in the Spring of 1922 was converted at Plymouth into a motor yacht, at the same time passing the Half-Time Survey.
